It has been further argued that the directive issued by the PEMRA is of generalized pattern, which does not contain any specification regarding respondent No.9, hence the same does not serve the purpose. Prays that during the pendency of the instant petition all concerned may be directed not to air/publish any speech/activity regarding Altaf Hussain/respondent No.9.

4. In view of arguments advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner and taking into consideration the submissions made by learned Additional Attorney General, as well as, learned Additional Advocate General, we are of the considered view that there is sufficient material available on record to issue direction to the Chairman, Pakistan Electronic Media Regulatory Authority, to completely black out the activities of Altaf Hussain/respondent No.9, including hatred speeches, any news regarding his activities, as well as, display of his picture on electronic media.

5. As far as print media is concerned, learned Additional Advocate General is directed to convey the order of this Court to the Chairman, Press Council of Pakistan, for immediate compliance.

6. Learned Additional Attorney General for Pakistan undertakes that the requisite report and parawise comments shall be submitted before the Court in the spirit of order dated 31.08.2015, before the next date of hearing. 7. For further proceedings to come up on 18.09.2015.
